## About Us

As Stambaugh Chorus embarks upon its 5<sup>th</sup> season, there are new joys and challenges. In his 4<sup>th</sup> year, Director Dr. Hae-Jong Lee envisions a spectacular season of singing. Bill Klein joins us this season as Assistant to the Conductor. Our returning accompanist is Alison Morris. As in seasons past, we will participate in Carols & Cocoa with Youngstown State University choral & instrumental ensembles. This year's highlight will be Karl Jenkins' *Gloria*. Collaboration with the Youngstown Area Community Concert Band in a free-will offering concert benefiting Second Harvest Food Bank completes the fall season. The Chorus will present a sing along concert of Handel's *Messiah* with area Choral ensembles in the spring. Our final concert in May will be a compilation of multi-cultural music.

Last year saw the premiere performance of Giving Voice to Peace Concert, including community choral groups, children and school choirs, as well as an Art Contest. The season finale spotlighted American composers & music. Since our formation in 2007, activities have included various collaborations such as: Verdi's *Requiem* with the Warren Philharmonic Orchestra and Beethoven's *Ninth Symphony* with the Greenville Symphony Orchestra, Shenango Valley Chorale, Thiel, Clairon and YSU Choruses. We are honored and pleased to maintain an ongoing relationship with the Dana School of Music as part of their yearly events.

The Chorus has entertained many through our outreach activities such as: Power Ministries events to collect food and clothing for the needy, St. Patrick Church in Youngstown, Austintown tree lightings, Briarfield at the Ridge, Park Vista and Omni Manor care facilities. The Chorus utilizes its outreach programs to create a deeper appreciation of choral music in the community, and we welcome people from every background to join us.
